Course Description

Certificate II in Retail Cosmetics (SHB20116) is an entry level qualification for the makeup industry. In addition to essential makeup application, students learn retail sales techniques, how to manage stock and assist with business marketing (with merchandising and social media).

To fulfil the requirements of this qualification, students are expected to undertake some practical industry experience within a personal services environment, this is available to students at the Clip Joint Education Salon. Please note you may be required to complete some of your salon services outside of your scheduled course hours.

Successful students will graduate with a nationally recognised qualification which can be used to seek employment as a Makeup Artist or work in a cosmetic retail environment. For VET in schools (SACE) students, the successful completion of the following units of competency is recognised towards 60 SACE Credits. If students decide to continue studies after gaining this qualification, some units may be available for credit transfer.
