Course Description

Certificate II in Salon Assistant (SHB20216) is an entry level hairdressing qualification which provides students with the skills required to effectively communicate in a salon environment, provide a range of client services and assist colleagues with salon operations.

To fulfil the requirements of this qualification, students are expected to undertake some practical industry experience within a hairdressing salon, this is available to students at the Clip Joint Education Salon. Please note you may be required to complete some of your salon services outside of your scheduled course hours.

Successful students will graduate with a nationally recognised qualification which can be used to seek employment as a Salon Assistant or as a pathway to a hairdressing apprenticeship. For students completing this as part of their VET in schools program, the successful completion of the following units of competency is recognised towards 45 SACE Credits. If students decide to continue studies after gaining this qualification, some units may be available for credit transfer.
