### Course Description

Certificate III in Barbering (SHB30516) is a specialised qualification for the hairdressing industry. In addition to razor shave techniques, this course provides graduates with cut, colour and shave techniques, scalp care and men's grooming.

This Apprentice Training Program enables students to undertake training in conjunction with employment. This competency-based training, places the emphasis on interaction between the salon owner, apprentice and educators. Please note, in addition to your on the job requirements within your workplace, you may be required to participate in and demonstrate your practical skills within Clip Joint Education's salon to ensure competency. This will be negotiated on a needs basis.

Successful students will graduate with a nationally recognised qualification which can be used to gain employment in a barber shop or salon. If students decide to continue studies after gaining this qualification, some units may be available for credit transfer.
