To fulfil the requirements of this qualification, students are expected to undertake some practical industry experience within a hairdressing salon, this is available to students at the Clip Joint Education Salon. Successful students will graduate with a nationally recognised qualification which can be used to seek employment as a Hairdresser. If students decide to continue studies after gaining this qualification, some units may be available for credit transfer.
