Course Description

Certificate III in Barbering SHB30516 is a specialised qualification for the hairdressing industry. In addition to razor shave techniques, this course provides graduates with cut, colour and shave techniques, scalp care and men's grooming.

To fulfil the requirements of this qualification, students are expected to undertake some practical industry experience within a hairdressing salon, this is available to students at the Clip Joint Education Salon. Please note you may be required to complete some of your salon services outside of your scheduled course hours.

Successful students will graduate with a nationally recognised qualification which can be used to gain employment in a barber shop or salon.

If students decide to continue studies after gaining this qualification, some units may be available for credit transfer or recognised prior learning.
